CRITERIA.

An approved 2024 WT Global License (WT Global Athlete License or Global Official License) is required by all athletes and officials who wish to register for the KASAD 6TH ASIAN TAEKWONDO OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024.

Senior (Male and Female), **KUKKIWON** Black Belt Only.

COMPETITION RULES & METHOD OF COMPETITION.

1. Poomsae Recognized – Single Elimination System.

2. Poomsae Freestyle – Cut Off System.

Rules and interpretation (In force as of May 14th , 2019).

POOMSAE.

The WT Poomsae Competition Rules as May 14, 2019 shall be applied.

- Recognized Poomsae, Single elimination Tournament System.

Individual : 2 (two) contestants will perform the Poomsae simultaneously on the mat.

Pair / Team : Each Pair / Team will perform the Poomsae separately.

- Recognized Poomsae competitions up to 90 seconds.
- Freestyle Poomsae, Cut-Off System.
- Freestyle Poomsae competition from 90 seconds to 100 seconds.
- Break time between 1st Poomsae and 2nd Poomsae is 30 seconds to 60 seconds.
- Grade: G1
- Seeding and Drawing of lots; For every category, regardless of number of athletes all the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of October.

COMPETITORS AGES

An athlete must be 18 years old or older in the year of KASAD 6th ASIAN TAEKWONDO OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024.

Athletes who were born in the year of 2006 or before are eligible for participation in the competition.

Senior (Male and Female), 17 years and over (**2007 and before**).

WT GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

- WT Global License Registration.

All athletes and Team Officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).

- WT Online Registration.

Participating Team entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. Participating Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open.

Registration is only accepted through the WT Event Registration system;

DEADLINE for online registration is **October, 1st 2024**.

- Entry Submissions after this date will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.
- The registered athletes or team officials may be replaced without penalty until October 7th, 2024.
- Entry Fee US \$50 per athlete will not be charged in case of cancellation of participation until October 7th, 2024.
- Entry Fee must be paid in full in case of the notice of cancellation of participating athletes after October 7th, 2024 or no-show.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORM

The participants shall wear the WT-recognized Taekwondo competition uniform.

Participating contestants must wear the WT-recognized Competition Uniform. Any contestant who does not wear WT-Approved Poomsae competition uniform will not be permitted to compete.

Standardization for Poomsae Competition Uniforms;

The mandatory Poomsae competition uniforms for competitors, have been standardized categories ;

Please change as below

- Senior Division** (Ages 18-49) : White top with dark blue pants for males; white top
With light pants for females.
- Master Division** (Ages 50 and up) : Yellow top and dark blue pants for both males and
females.



ENTRY FEE.

US\$50 per Athlete for Poomsae Recognized or Freestyle Poomsae Discipline.

Contestants may compete in up to two divisions of competition, and will be charged **US\$100.**

The entry fee can be deposited directly to the host county/MNA at the venue, as cash payment.

DEADLINE for online registration is **October, 1st 2024.**

IMPORTANT ;

If the athlete registered online does not take part in the competition for some reason, but he/she has not been removed from their list of participants before the deadline October 1st, 2024, his/her team officially must fully 100% pay his/her entry fee for the participation.

TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and ATU will appoint four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

- i. The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition at least three (3) days before and one (1) day after the tournament.
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate and US\$150 to the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period.
 - Check In : Date October 13th ,2024.
 - Check Out : Date October 20th ,2024.

INTERNATIONAL REFEREE.

1. The Round-trip airfares shall be borne by each participating International Referee.
2. The Organizing Committee will provide each participating International referee with a daily allowance as per the rules of WT and accommodation.
3. Boarding/Lodging will be provided as below :
 - International Referees
 - Check In : Date October 13th ,2024.
 - Check Out : Date October 20th ,2024.
4. The Organizing Committee shall cover the per diem for International Referees in accordance with the WT Finance Rules.

CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS / MEDALS / TROPHIES / CERTIFICATES

POOMSAE.

Individual Awards, medals will be awarded to the top four (4) athletes in the respective poomsae divisions of the pertinent championships;

- 1st Place : Gold Medal and Certificate.
- 2nd Place : Silver Medal and Certificate.
- 3rd Place : Bronze Medal and Certificate.
- 4th Place : Bronze Medal and Certificate.
- 5th – 8th Place : Certificate.

BEST TEAM.

Male Team and Female Team ; 1st, 2nd and 3rd (combined medal tally).

Team standing is determined by the number and value of the medals earned by the individuals of a team.

- The team with the higher number of gold medals won.
- In the case of a tie In Gold medals won the rank shall be decided by;
 - Number of Silver and Bronze medals won by the team.
 - Number of participating contestants.

(Article 7.1 of WT Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation)

All international-level competitions recognized by the WT shall be formed with participating of at least six (6) countries in tournament with no less than six (6) contestants competed in each weight category and any tournament with less than six (6) countries or weight category with less than 6 (six) competed contestant cannot be recognized in the official results.

Accordingly, the points achieved by unrecognized weight categories/divisions will not be included in the Team Standing.

Best Coaches : 3 (three) Coaches from 1ST, 2ND, and 3RD Best Team.

Best Athletes : 1 (one) Male and 1 (one) Female.

Good Fighting Spirit : 2 (two) regardless of gender.

Best Referees : 3 (three) regardless of gender.

Certificate of Participation: it will be given to all participants who participate in this event including the athletes, referees and coaches.

In the case of Pair and Team, the certificate will be given to each team member including the substitute.

Dress Code for Medallist: all medallist should be dressed as follow during the awards ceremony ; Dobok or National Team Training Suits, Sneakers or Taekwondo Shoes.

DRAW SHEET AND BRACKET PUBLICATION.

The draw sheets and brackets will be published after Head of Team meeting and names for random weight-in will be available at 6.00 am every morning.

INDEMNITIES.

1. The respective Participants shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel and medical insurance coverage.
2. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the championships.
3. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

MEDICAL CONTROL.

Uses of any drugs or chemical substances are strictly prohibited; offenses shall be subjected to disciplinary action according to the prescribed Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations.

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form [HERE](#) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day. TEAM DOCTOR’S MEETING

In order to receive accreditation card, all registered team doctors or physicians must attend team doctor’s meeting on October 14th, 2024.

COACHING REQUIREMENTS.

For the Coach of the Poomsae does not need WT Coach Certificate.

For all coaches it is mandatory to wear formal suit when their athletes enter the Semi-Final round and Final round.

HEAD OF MEETING AND DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION

The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted One (1) day prior to the start of the competition is October 17th 2024 in the presence of the WT Technical Delegate & ATU officials and the representatives of the participating teams.

At least one representative from each team must be attend the Head of Meeting. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform Technical Delegate or WT Sport & Event Management Department before the meeting.

- Draw will be published on the official ATU/OC website.

- Two Designated Poomsae will be announced at the Head of Team meeting.
- Every participating team is required to bring USB or (CD/DVD) of the Freestyle Poomsae Music at the head of team meeting and submit it to the OC staff.
- Every participating team is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing ceremonies:
 - Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm.
 - USB or (CD/DVD) of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem.

Additional Notes:

- Participating teams are responsible for confirming their entries before the head of team meeting.
- A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking, and it will be announced at the head of the team meeting.

ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Each team is responsible for cost related to the Accommodation, and Food.

Participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation to the assigned email of the Organizing Committee by no later than October 1st ,2024.

Daily Shuttle Bus between designated/official hotels and venue will be provided for participating teams, if participants stay at a designated hotel by the organizing committee.

Participating teams must submit necessary information, such as date, time of arrival, flight information and so on to the Organizing Committee by no later than **October 1st ,2024**.

ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the participants can officially request to the ATU for the replacement by no later than October 1st 2024 by submitting 'Athlete Late Replacement Form' together with certification from the medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to admin@asiantu.org and admin@taekwondo.or.id. The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.
